

To the Director of the State Tax Agency:

By paying taxes, I contribute to financing the state's expenses. For reasons of conscience, and after analysing the sense of those expenses in society, I cannot and do not wish to collaborate with any expenses that do not contribute to the common good and that are only used in benefit to a privileged minority, versus the needs of the vast majority of society.

Therefore, I hereby expressly declare my status as a person on tax strike. In accordance with this position, I have deposited ..... euros in the account of ....., an entity or collective that takes part socially in a field that is necessary for creating truly public resources. As stated above, this part of my tax, which I am not using to evade taxes but rather am diverting to a socially useful purpose, corresponds to my refusal to pay expenses such as those for the army, for debt, for the church, for the monarchy, etc., which prevent the most important social needs from being satisfied. I hereby request that the Tax Strike be admitted in order to take money away from injustice, with no desire to evade taxes, as it can be inferred from the publicity given to the 2015 Tax Strike Campaign and from this very letter.
